Group Size: A minimum of 9 students plus 1 chaperone constitutes a group. The museum will admit up to 75 students per hour for guided tours (not to exceed 150 students per school, per day), and 100 students per hour for self-guided tours.

Adult Chaperones: One adult chaperone is required for every 15 students on a guided tour, or for every 10 students on a self-guided tour.
