For each school, Art Adventure tour groups are 60 students per hour, limited to 120 students per day. For guided tours, one Art Adventure guide is assigned to every 15 students. Schools must provide at least one adult chaperone for every 15 students on guided tours and for every 10 students on self-guided tours.
