

Bus Transportation Grants to the MIA for 2013–2014

Bring your students to the Minneapolis Institute of Arts—with a little help from the Friends!

The MIA's trained tour guides offer a variety of tours based on the museum's permanent and special exhibitions. Tours encompass art objects from almost every culture and period in history. Guides will custom-design a tour to coordinate with your classroom studies and special interests. Tours last one hour and are available Tuesday through Friday.

To help make tours for students possible, **Friends of the Institute**, an organization dedicated to raising funds to support the museum within the community, has made a fund available to provide bus transportation to 1st-8th graders in Twin Cities-area schools. Our goal is to reach as many children as possible who might otherwise lack this opportunity to visit the MIA.

If your school is interested in participating, please complete the attached form and return it by fax or e-mail no later than October 1, 2013. Admission to the museum is free, and bus transportation will be awarded based on need. The award amount will be made directly to the school after the tour. Awards will be flat rates based on the school's distance from the museum. If the flat rate presents a hardship that prevents your students from coming to the museum, please explain on a separate page and submit it with your bus application form.
